LRS 39:95 requires that the State Treasurer report to the Revenue Estimating Conference the balance of the Budget Stabilization Fund as of July first, the beginning, of each fiscal year.

The balance of the Budget Stabilization Fund for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023 was \$974,722,732.95. This balance includes the following:

- \$181,630,129 was transferred into the fund from the State General Fund representing the non-recurring revenue from the FY22 surplus. This surplus was recognized by the Revenue Estimating Conference on May 18, 2023, and Act 410 of the 2023 Regular Legislative Session directed the transfer into the Budget Stabilization Fund.
- \$71,871,528 of mineral revenues was deposited into the Budget Stabilization Fund. In accordance with LA Constitution Article 7 Section 10.16 and LRS 39:93 (A)(2), mineral revenues in excess of \$950 million after dedications shall be deposited into the fund.
- \$1,353,418 of interest earnings during the fiscal year.

LRS 39:95 also requires the Revenue Estimating Conference to certify one-third of the Budget Stabilization Fund balance of each fiscal year. One-third of the beginning balance of the Budget Stabilization Fund for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023 is \$324,907,577.65.
