

DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY

Office of the Governor Board of Examiners of Certified Shorthand Reporters

Continuing Education Credits (LAC 46:XXI.661)

In accordance with the emergency provisions of the Administrative Procedure Act, R.S. 49:953.1, the Board of Examiners of Certified Shorthand Reporters declares an emergency to exist because of the ongoing effect of the pandemic and adopts by emergency process the attached Rule relative to accepting live webinars for continuing education credits.

This Rule shall have the force and effect of law on October 15, 2021, and will remain in effect for the maximum period allowed by the Administrative Procedure Act, unless renewed by the Board of Examiners of Certified Shorthand Reporters, or until permanent rules are promulgated in accordance with the law.

Part XXI. Certified Shorthand Reporters

Chapter 6. Continuing Education

§611. Activities Not Acceptable for Continuing Education Credits

A. Completion of any certified pulmonary respiratory course will not be accepted for continuing education credits.

B. Attendance at or participation in tours, exhibits, entertainment, recreation, committee service, association business, home study, or on-line courses or seminars will not be accepted for continuing education credits, except that live webinars will be accepted for continuing education credits.
