

**MINUTES OF THE
LOUISIANA ARCHITECTS SELECTION BOARD
July 17, 2024**

A meeting of the Louisiana Architects Selection Board (LASB) was held in the Claiborne Building, 1201 N. Third Street, Room 1-100 Louisiana Purchase Room, Baton Rouge, Louisiana 70802 on July 17, 2024.
