



Now, therefore, having complied with all the formalities prescribed by law and the above described ands, failing to sell, not receiving a bid therefore, equal to the amount of taxes, interest and costs due thereon, I, NEWMAN H. deBRETTON Sheriff and ex officio Tax Collector of said Parish, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the laws of the State of Louisiana, and in accordance with Section 53 of Act 170 of 1898, as amended and re-enacted by Sec. 1 of Act 315 of 1910, aforesaid, each specific piece of property hereinbefore described, was respectively and separately adjudicated to the State of Louisiana. And now in pursuance of said adjudication, and by virtue of the provisions of Collector, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell, assign, set over and deliver unto said the State of Louisiana the property hereinbefore described with all improvements thereon, etc.; provided, that the said properties herein sold are subject to redemption by the said taxpayer or any person interested personally, or as heir, legatee, creditor or otherwise, at any time for the space of 3 years from the date on which this deed or act of sale shall be filed for record in the Conveyance Office of this Parish, upon payment of the said taxpayer or interested person, to the said vendee herein, or its legal representatives, the said price of adjudication with 5% penalty and interest at the rate of 1% per month until redeemed and all costs added: IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto signed my name at BATON ROUGE Parish of EAST BATON ROUGE this 17th day of JUNE in the year of our Lord one thousand NINETEEN HUNDRED AND FORTY in the presence of R.
