## STATE ACCEPTING PUBLIC COMMENTS ON ACTION PLAN AMENDMENT FOR RECOVERY FROM THE GREAT FLOODS OF 2016

The Louisiana Office of Community Development is accepting public comments on an action plan amendment to reallocate \$19 million in federal funding for recovery from The Great Floods of 2016. This APA is considered substantial, as the reallocation of funds is more than \$5 million and constitutes a change of 15% or more of a program budget. The 14-day public comment period begins today and ends at **5 p.m. Jan 2, 2024.** 

The Great Floods of 2016 Action Plan Amendment 23 will:

- Decrease the Fast Gap B (Rental Affordability Preservation) program by \$15 million;
- Decrease the Multifamily Rental GAP program by \$4.4 million;
- Increase the Watershed Modeling and Planning budget by \$10.4 million;
- Increase the PRO Louisiana Workforce Development budget by \$5 million; and
- Increase the Regional Capacity Building Grant budget by \$4 million.
