The Division of Administration, Office of the Commissioner (COA) hereby submits the following report for 2024 in accordance with La. R.S. 49:966K.

The COA adopted the following rule:

- In response to Act 393 of the 2023 Regular Session, the COA adopted LAC 4:XXIII.Chapter 1, a rule concerning accommodating people with disabilities so they may participate via electronic means in public meetings of DOA public bodies. The rule was published in the April 2024 *Louisiana Register*, Volume 50, Number 4, p. 516.

The COA adopted the following fee rule:

- In accordance with the provisions of R.S. 49:962, R.S. 39:241, and R.S. 44:32, the COA adopted LAC 55:I.903, an emergency rule setting forth fees for state police video public records as a supplement to the Uniform Fee Schedule—LAC 4:I.301. The emergency rule was published in the August 2024 *Louisiana Register*, Volume 50, Number 8, p. 1132.

The COA received no petitions or submissions under La. R.S. 49:964.
