## MEETING MINUTES

A public meeting of the Interim Emergency Board was held in Senate Committee Room A on January 14, 2014, at 3:00 p.m.

Mr. Moses explained that these projects had Priority 1 lines of credit that were rescinded at the October and November Bond Commission meetings because it was not expected that the cash would be needed in this fiscal year. Either the projects had another means of financing or they had more cash than was needed for their specific stage of project development. Thus, he was asking that the priorities be changed in order to allow noncash lines of credit to be granted at the February Bond Commission meeting. Following that, his staff will be able to review each of the projects for cash flow needs during the capital outlay bill development.

Sen. Alario asked if these actions would provide the opportunity to continue some funding and so none of those projects would be in danger of losing funding at this point. Mr. Moses answered yes and explained that since the capital outlay lines of credit had already been rescinded, this action would actually provide the opportunity to have a noncash line of credit granted at the February Bond Commission meeting.

Commissioner Nichols asked Mr. Moses if this action would in any way hamper the current progress of these projects. Mr. Moses said it should not, as his staff has already reviewed the projects and does not anticipate that they would need funding this year. Thus, this action would give them the opportunity to further review the projects and determine if they will need cash in FY15. Then if cash is needed, they will be able to reauthorize them as Priority 1 and the projects would receive a cash line of credit in July. The majority of the projects had sufficient cash flow for the current year to continue to meet their implementation schedules, and this action would help them meet their schedules and to make decisions down the road.

With no further discussion, Commissioner Nichols motioned approval, which was seconded by Sen. Kleckley.

With no other business before the board, Lt. Gov. Dardenne moved to adjourn, which was seconded by Mr. Henson. The meeting was adjourned at 3:07 p.m.
